The European Union has committed to promote culture, art and creative industries. Among the most important projects in this context are the annual designation of two European Capitals of Culture, as well as the establishment of sponsoring for cultural events, film festivals or art awards. During the current pandemic period, the promotion of digital cultural services, to which the European Union is committed, is also increasing rapidly. This support aims especially at making cultural services available in all EU Member States.

A cross-border region, such as the Upper Rhine, has the advantage of being able to benefit from the cultural offerings of its neighboring country. However, this advantage is combined with many obstacles, such as a lack of knowledge of the neighboring country's language and a lack of information regarding what is available there. Thus, there is still a great need for action in the field of culture, especially at the local and regional level.

What makes up a cross-border culture? And how can it be supported in the current crisis? What kind of cross-border cultural projects would you like to benefit from and how can you strengthen the curiosity towards your neighbor's cultural offer?
